## The Syria (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019

#### PART 8

#### Information and records

#### **Part 8: supplementary**

- **78.**—(1) A disclosure of information under regulation 77 [Flor 77A] does not breach any restriction on such disclosure imposed by statute or otherwise.
  - (2) But nothing in [F2those regulations] authorises a disclosure that—
    - (a) contravenes the data protection legislation, or
    - (b) is prohibited by any of Parts 1 to 7 or Chapter 1 of Part 9 of the Investigatory Powers Act 2016 M1.
- (3) Nothing in this Part is to be read as requiring a person who has acted or is acting as counsel or solicitor for any person to disclose any privileged information in their possession in that capacity.
- (4) [F3Regulations 77 and 77A do] not limit the circumstances in which information may be disclosed apart from [F4those regulations].
  - (5) Nothing in this Part limits any conditions which may be contained in a licence under Part 7.
  - (6) In this regulation—
    - "the data protection legislation" has the same meaning as in the Data Protection Act 2018 (see section 3 of that Act) M2;
    - "privileged information" means information with respect to which a claim to legal professional privilege (in Scotland, to confidentiality of communications) could be maintained in legal proceedings.
