EXITING THE EUROPEAN UNION ARCHITECTS

The Architects Act 1997 (Swiss Qualifications) (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019

Made	4th April 2019
Laid before Parliament	5th April 2019
Coming into force in accordance with regulation 1	

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by-

- (a) in relation to regulation 1, the provisions mentioned in paragraphs (b) and (c);
- (b) in relation to regulation 2, section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972^{MI};
- (c) in relation to regulations 3 and 4, section 8(1) of, and paragraph 21(b) of Schedule 7 to, the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018^{M2}.

The Secretary of State is a Minister designated ^{M3} for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 in relation to the recognition of higher-education diplomas, formal qualifications, or experience in the occupation, required for the pursuit of professions or occupations.

The Secretary of State is of the opinion that, by reason of urgency, it is necessary to make these Regulations without a draft of the instrument being laid before, and approved by a resolution of, each House of Parliament ^{M4}.
