The Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019

PART 1

General

Purposes

- **4.** The regulations contained in this instrument that are made under section 1 of the Act are for the purposes of $[F^I]$
 - [F2(a)] encouraging Russia to cease actions destabilising Ukraine or undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty or independence of Ukraine.
 - [F3(b)] promoting the payment of compensation by Russia for damage, loss or injury suffered by Ukraine on or after 24th February 2022 as a result of Russia's invasion of Ukraine.]
