# **PUBLIC HEALTH, ENGLAND**

The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (Self-Isolation) (England) Regulations 2020

Approved by both Houses of Parliament

Made	at 5.00 p.m. on 27th September 2020
Laid before Parliament	28th September 2020
Coming into force	at 12.00 a.m on 28th September 2020

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45B, 45C(1) and (3)(c), 45D, 45F(2), 45P and 45T(6) of the Public Health (Control of Disease) Act 1984 Act <sup>MI</sup>, makes the following Regulations.

These Regulations are made in response to the serious and imminent threat to public health which is posed by the incidence and spread of severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) in England.

The Secretary of State considers that the restrictions and requirements imposed by these Regulations are proportionate to what they seek to achieve, which is a public health response to that threat.

In accordance with section 45R of that Act the Secretary of State is of the opinion that, by reason of urgency, it is necessary to make this instrument without a draft having been laid before, and approved by a resolution of, each House of Parliament.
