# The Land Registry Trading Fund (Revocation) Order 2020

Made - - - - - 4th February 2020

Coming into force - - 1st April 2020

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1 and 6(1) of the Government Trading Funds Act 1973(a), with the concurrence of the Treasury, makes the following Order:

### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Land Registry Trading Fund (Revocation) Order 2020 and comes into force on the 1st April 2020.
