**ENERGY CONSERVATION**

**The Energy Information (Amendment) Regulations 2020**

*Made* - - - - at 1.25 p.m. on 2nd November 2020

*Laid before Parliament* at 4.30 p.m. on 2nd November 2020

*Coming into force* - - - - 23rd November 2020

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(a).

The Secretary of State is a Minister designated(b) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 in relation to the environmental aspects of product design.

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Energy Information (Amendment) Regulations 2020 and come into force on 23rd November 2020.

**Amendment of the Energy Information Regulations 2011**

2.—(1) The table set out in paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 (EU measures) to the Energy Information Regulations 2011(c) is amended as follows.

(2) For the entry relating to household combined washer-driers, substitute—

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

This instrument amends the Energy Information Regulations 2011 (S.I. 2011/1524) in relation to household combined washer-dryers, household washing machines, household dishwashers, household refrigerating appliances and electronic displays. It substitutes new Commission Delegated Regulations into the list of EU measures in Schedule 1 to the Energy Information Regulations 2011 which allows them to be enforced by the market surveillance authorities.

A full impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no, or no significant, impact on the private, voluntary or public sector is foreseen.

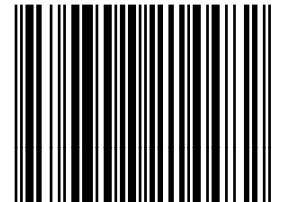
