**REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE, ENGLAND**

The Representation of the People (Variation of Limits of  
Candidates' Election Expenses) (England) Order 2020

*Made* - - - - 21st December 2020  
22nd December  
*Coming into force* - - 2020

The Minister for the Cabinet Office, considering it expedient in consequence of changes in the value of money, makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 76A(1)(a) of the Representation of the People Act 1983(1), and now vested in the Minister(2).

- (1) 1983 c. 2; section 76A was inserted by section 14 of the Representation of the People Act 1985 (c. 50) and substituted by section 133(1) of the Political Parties, Elections and Referendums Act 2000 (c. 41).
- (2) The Secretary of State's functions under section 76A were exercisable concurrently with the Lord President of the Council by virtue of S.I. 2010/1837. By virtue of S.I. 2015/1376, the Secretary of State's functions which were exercisable concurrently with the Lord President ceased to be so exercisable and were instead exercisable concurrently with the Chancellor of the Duchy of Lancaster. By virtue of S.I. 2016/997, the Secretary of State's functions which were exercisable concurrently with the Chancellor of the Duchy of Lancaster ceased to be so exercisable and are instead exercisable concurrently with the Minister for the Cabinet Office.
