## The Criminal Procedure (Amendment No. 2) (Coronavirus) Rules 2020

## **Amendments to the Criminal Procedure Rules**

- **14.** In Part 50 (Extradition)—
  - (a) in rule 50.3 (Exercise of magistrates' court's powers)—
    - (i) for paragraph (2) substitute—
      - "(2) If the court so directs, a person must attend a hearing by live video link."; and
    - (ii) for the second paragraph of the note at the end of the rule substitute—
      - "Under sections 206A to 206C of the 2003 Act(1)the court may require a person to attend by live video link any hearing to which the rules in Sections 2 and 4 of this Part apply."; and
  - (b) in rule 50.17 (Exercise of High Court's powers), in paragraph (2) for "party" substitute "person".
