EXITING THE EUROPEAN UNION SANCTIONS

The Lebanon (Sanctions) (Assassination of Rafiq Hariri and others) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020

The Secretary of State(1), in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1)(a) and (3)(a), 3(1) (a) and (d)(i), 9(2)(b), 13, 15(2)(a) and (b), (3) and (6), 16, 17(2) to (5) and (8), 21(1), 54(1) and (2), 56(1) and 62(4) and (5) of the Sanctions and Anti-Money Laundering Act 2018(2), and having decided, upon consideration of the matters set out in section 56(1) of that Act, that it is appropriate to do so, makes the following Regulations:
