REPORTING AND ACCESS RESTRICTIONS

Representations in response

6.7.—(1) This rule applies where a party, or person directly affected, wants to make representations about an application or appeal.

- (2) Such a party or person must—
 - (a) serve the representations on—
 - (i) the court officer,
 - (ii) the applicant,
 - (iii) each other party, and
 - (iv) such other person (if any) as the court directs;
 - (b) do so as soon as reasonably practicable after notice of the application; and
 - (c) ask for a hearing, if that party or person wants one, and explain why it is needed.
- (3) Representations must—
 - (a) explain the reasons for any objection; and
 - (b) specify any alternative terms proposed.
