Provision coming into force on 24th August 2020

- **2.**—(1) Section 28 of the Act(1) (video recorded cross-examination or re-examination) comes into force on 24thAugust 2020 in relation to relevant proceedings.
 - (2) Proceedings are relevant for the purposes of paragraph (1) if—
 - (a) they take place before the Crown Court sitting at—
 - (i) Basildon;
 - (ii) Canterbury;
 - (iii) the Central Criminal Court;
 - (iv) Chelmsford;
 - (v) Croydon;
 - (vi) Guildford;
 - (vii) Harrow;
 - (viii) the Inner London Sessions House;
 - (ix) Isleworth;
 - (x) Lewes;
 - (xi) Maidstone;
 - (xii) Snaresbrook;
 - (xiii) Southwark;
 - (xiv) Stafford;
 - (xv) Wood Green, or
 - (xvi) Woolwich, and
 - (b) the witness is eligible for assistance by virtue of section 16 of the Act(2) (witnesses eligible for assistance on grounds of age or incapacity).
