## **Additional exemptions**

- 2. Chapter 2 of Part 2 of these Regulations does not apply to—
  - (a) double-capped fluorescent T5 light sources with power  $P \le 13$  W;
  - (b) electronic displays (such as televisions, computer monitors, notebooks, tablets, mobile phones, e-readers, game consoles), including displays to which the following provisions apply—
    - (i) Chapter 7 of Part 2 of the Ecodesign for Energy-Related Products and Energy Information Regulations 2021(1);
    - (ii) Commission Regulation (EU) No 617/2013 of 26 June 2013(2) implementing Directive 2009/125/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for computers and computer servers;
  - (c) light sources and separate control gears in battery-operated products, including—
    - (i) torches;
    - (ii) mobile phones with an integrated torch light;
    - (iii) toys with included light sources;
    - (iv) desk lamps operating only on batteries;
    - (v) armband lamps for cyclists;
    - (vi) solar-powered garden lamps;
  - (d) light sources for spectroscopy and photometric applications, including—
    - (i) UV-VIS spectroscopy;
    - (ii) molecular spectroscopy;
    - (iii) atomic absorption spectroscopy;
    - (iv) nondispersive infrared (NDIR);
    - (v) fourier-transform infrared (FTIR);
    - (vi) medical analysis;
    - (vii) ellipsometry;
    - (viii) layer thickness measurement;
    - (ix) process monitoring;
    - (x) environmental monitoring;
  - (e) light sources and separate control gears on bicycles and other non-motorised vehicles.
