PUBLIC SERVICE PENSIONS

The Judicial Pensions (Fee-Paid Judges) (Amendment) Regulations 2021

The Lord Chancellor makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 18A and 29(3) of the Judicial Pensions and Retirement Act 1993⁽¹⁾.

In accordance with section 29(2A) of that Act⁽²⁾ a draft of this instrument has been laid before and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.
