#### Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Mobile Homes (Requirement for Manager of Site to be Fit and Proper Person) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2021.
  - (2) These Regulations come into force on the day after the day on which they are made.
