**TRADE**

**Interpretation of regulations 3 to 5**

**6.** In regulations 3 to 5—

“data protection legislation” has the same meaning as in the Data Protection Act 2018<sup>(1)</sup>;

“EEA EFTA Agreement” means the Free Trade Agreement between Iceland, the Principality of Liechtenstein and the Kingdom of Norway and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland<sup>(2)</sup>;

“relevant trading partner” means a Party, other than the United Kingdom, to the EEA EFTA Agreement;

“the Executive” means the Health and Safety Executive<sup>(3)</sup>.
