
EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

The Statutory Sick Pay (Coronavirus) (Funding of Employers' Liabilities) Regulations 2022 ([S.I. 2022/5](#)) and the Statutory Sick Pay (Coronavirus) (Funding of Employers' Liabilities) (Northern Ireland) Regulations 2022 ([S.I. 2022/9](#)) provide for certain small and medium size employers to reclaim some, or all, of their Statutory Sick Pay costs relating to coronavirus from Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs. These Regulations amend those instruments to end employers' ability to reclaim Statutory Sick Pay costs for coronavirus related absences which occur after 17th March 2022.
