CHAPTER 5

Retention of functions from the Batteries Directive

Power to grant exemptions from labelling requirements

- **13.**—(1) The Secretary of State may, by regulations, make provision for exemptions from the labelling requirements for batteries, accumulators and battery packs.
- (2) The provision which may be made under paragraph (1) includes provision modifying Commission Regulation (EU) No 1103/2010 establishing, pursuant to Directive 2006/66/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council, rules as regards capacity labelling of portable secondary (rechargeable) and automotive batteries and accumulators(1).
 - (3) Regulations under paragraph (1) may modify any subordinate legislation.
- (4) In paragraph (1), "labelling requirements for batteries, accumulators and battery packs", means the labelling requirements contained in regulations 5, 5A and 6 of, and Schedule 1 to, the Batteries and Accumulators (Placing on the Market) Regulations 2008(2).
