The Secretary of State(1), considering that the requirements of section 45(2) of the Sanctions and Anti-Money Laundering Act 2018(2) are met, makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1, 7(1) to (5) and (8), 10(2) to (4), 11, 14, 15(2) and (3), 16, 17(2) to (5), 21(1), 26, 45, 54(1) and (2), and 62(6) of that Act:

The power to make regulations under Part 1 of the Sanctions and Anti-Money Laundering Act 2018 (c. 13) is conferred on an appropriate Minister. Section 1(9)(a) of the Act defines an "appropriate Minister" as including the Secretary of State.
