**The Food Information (Amendment)
(England) Regulations 2022**

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 16(1) (e), 26(3) and 48(1) of the Food Safety Act 1990⁽¹⁾.

The Secretary of State has had regard to relevant advice given by the Food Standards Agency in accordance with section 48(4A) of the Food Safety Act 1990⁽²⁾.

There has been consultation as required by Article 9 of Regulation [\(EC\) No 178/2002](#) of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety⁽³⁾ during the preparation, evaluation and revision of food law in relation to these Regulations.
