**The Alcohol Licensing (Coronavirus) (Regulatory
Easements) (Amendment) Regulations 2022**

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 11(14) of the Business and Planning Act 2020⁽¹⁾.

The Secretary of State considers it reasonable to substitute the date specified in section 172F(10)(d)(i) of the Licensing Act 2003⁽²⁾, as that Act has effect by virtue of section 11(2) of the Business and Planning Act 2020⁽³⁾, and the date specified in section 11(13) of the Business and Planning Act 2020⁽⁴⁾, with a later date in order to mitigate an effect of coronavirus⁽⁵⁾.

(3) Section 11(2) of the Business and Planning Act 2020 modifies Part 9 of the Licensing Act 2003 so that it has effect as if, after section 172E, there were inserted sections 172F to 172L, for a limited period.
