<p><b>How to vote as a proxy</b> At the polling station, tell the staff that you are a proxy for the person named on the front of this card. Show an accepted form of photographic identification for yourself. They will give you that person's ballot paper. <b>If you need any help, just ask the staff.</b></p>	<p><b>The person you are proxy for can vote themselves if they wish – but only if you have not already voted on their behalf.</b></p>
<p><b>If you are away or cannot go to the polling station on [day] [date of poll] you can do one of the following:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Apply to vote by post. The deadline for completed applications is 5pm on [day] [date of deadline].</li><li>• If you are given a postal vote, you or the person you are proxy for will not be able to vote in person at this election.</li></ul> <p><b>To find out how to apply, please contact us.</b></p>	<p><b>📞 If you need any help, require information in another format or language or wish to find out if your polling station is accessible, please contact us.</b> <i>[Insert helpline and other contact details including website]</i></p>
