The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Nottingham Goose Fair) Regulations 2023

Made - - - - 6th July 2023

Coming into force - - 29th September 2023

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict the flying of unmanned aircraft in the area specified in regulation 3(1) by reason of the intended gathering there of a large number of persons at the Nottingham Goose Fair.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Nottingham Goose Fair) Regulations 2023 and they come into force on 29th September 2023.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3(1) the times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time(**b**).

Restricted airspace

- **3.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 1400 hours on 29th September 2023 and 2300 hours on 8th October 2023 no unmanned aircraft is to fly below 1,300 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 0.4 nautical miles centred at 525758N 0010938W.
- (2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any unmanned aircraft flying in accordance with a permission issued by Nottinghamshire Police.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on the flying of unmanned aircraft in the vicinity of Nottingham City Centre by reason of the large gathering of persons expected to attend the Nottingham Goose Fair which is due to be held there on 29th September 2023 to 8th October 2023 (inclusive).

At the request of the Nottinghamshire Police, the Civil Aviation Authority and the Department for Transport agree that the flying of unmanned aircraft should be restricted in the vicinity of the fair for reasons of public safety.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC) which is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).

In relation to the permission mentioned in regulation 3(2), Nottinghamshire Police may be contacted as notified.

Full details of this Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular (AIC) and Notice to Aviation (NOTAM).
