The Environmental Targets (Water) (England) Regulations 2023

## PART 1

#### Introduction

#### Citation, commencement and extent

- **1.**—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Environmental Targets (Water) (England) Regulations 2023.
  - (2) These Regulations come into force on the day after the day on which they are made.
  - (3) These Regulations extend to England and Wales.

### Interpretation

- 2. In these Regulations—
  - "the Act" means the Environment Act 2021;
  - "coastal waters" has the meaning given in section 104 of the Water Resources Act 1991(1);
  - "freshwaters" has the same meaning as "inland freshwaters" in section 104 of the Water Resources Act 1991(2).

#### Water targets

**3.** Regulations 5, 10, 15 and 20 specify four targets for the purposes of the Secretary of State's duty in section 1 of the Act to set a long-term target in respect of water.
