**The Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Rules 2024**

**Amendments to the Criminal Procedure Rules**

**13.** In Part 50 (Extradition), in rule 50.3 (Exercise of magistrates' court's powers)—

(a) for paragraph (2) substitute—

“(2) If the court so directs, a person must attend a hearing by live link.”; and

(b) for the second paragraph of the note to the rule substitute—

*“Under sections 206A to 206C of the 2003 Act<sup>(1)</sup>, the court may require a person to attend a hearing by live link. See also rules 3.35 to 3.39 about live links.”.*
