**The Cardiff and Vale National Health  
Service Trust Establishment Order 1999**

*Made* - - - - - *15 December 1999*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *1 January 2000*

The National Assembly for Wales makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State for Wales by section 5(1) of and paragraphs 1, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 2 to the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990<sup>(1)</sup>, section 25(2) of the Welsh Language Act 1993<sup>(2)</sup> and of all other powers enabling the Secretary of State in that behalf and now vested in the National Assembly for Wales<sup>(3)</sup>, after completion of the consultation prescribed under section 5(2) of the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990<sup>(4)</sup>:
