**The National Health Service (Choice of Medical Practitioner) Amendment (Wales) Regulations 2000**

*Made* - - - - 21st June 2000  
*Coming into force* - - 1st July 2000

The National Assembly for Wales makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 28F(1) and (2) and 126(4) of the National Health Service Act 1977<sup>(1)</sup> and all other powers enabling it in that behalf:—
