**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Mae Adran 484 o Ddeddf Addysg 1996 yn galluogi Cynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru i wneud rheoliadau sydd yn darparu ar gyfer talu grantiau ynglŷn â gwariant a dynnwyd gan awdurdodau addysg lleol at ddibenion addysgol, neu mewn cysylltiad â hwy, os ymddengys i'r Cynulliad Cenedlaethol y dylid annog y fath wariant er lles addysg yng Nghymru. Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn darparu ar gyfer talu'r fath grantiau. Maent yn ailddeddfu, gyda rhai newidiadau, Rheoliadau Addysg (Grantiau Safonau Addysg) (Cymru) 1999. Amlinellir darpariaethau'r Rheoliadau, a'r newidiadau i'r Rheoliadau cynt, isod.

Section 484 of the Education Act 1996 enables the National Assembly for Wales to make regulations providing for the payment of grants in respect of expenditure incurred by local education authorities for or in connection with educational purposes which it appears to the National Assembly those authorities should be encouraged to incur in the interests of education in Wales. These Regulations provide for the payment of such grants. They re-enact, with some changes, the Education (Education Standards Grants) (Wales) Regulations 1999. The provisions of the Regulations, and the changes from the earlier Regulations, are outlined below.

Mae **Rheoliad 1** yn darparu ar gyfer enwi, cychwyn a chymhwyso. Daw'r rheoliadau i rym ar 1 Ebrill 2000 ac maent yn gymwys i Gymru'n unig.

**Regulation 1:** provides for citation, commencement and application. The regulations come into force on 1st April 2000 and apply only in relation to Wales.

Mae **Rheoliad 2** yn cynnwys diffiniadau.

**Regulation 2:** contains definitions.

Mae **Rheoliad 3** yn darparu nad yw grantiau'n daladwy ond ar gyfer gwariant a dynnwyd gan awdurdodau addysg lleol at y dibenion, neu mewn cysylltiad â'r dibenion, a nodir yn yr Atodlen yn ystod blwyddyn ariannol, ac ond i'r graddau y cymeradwywyd y gwariant am y flwyddyn honno gan y Cynulliad Cenedlaethol at ddibenion y Rheoliadau.

**Regulation 3:** provides for grants to be payable only in respect of expenditure incurred by a local education authority for or in connection with the purposes specified in the Schedule in a financial year, and only to the extent that the expenditure is approved for that year by the National Assembly for the purposes of the Regulations.

Mae **Rheoliad 4** yn darparu ar gyfer talu grantiau ynglŷn â gwariant gan awdurdodau addysg lleol i dalu trydydd partïon am wariant ganddynt os byddai'r gwariant hwnnw'n gymwys ar gyfer grant petai'n wariant gan yr awdurdod.

**Regulation 4:** provides for payment of grants in respect of expenditure incurred by local education authorities in making payments to third parties in respect of expenditure incurred by those third parties which would be eligible for grant if it were expenditure of the authority.

Mae **Rheoliad 5** yn darparu ar gyfer cyfradd y grantiau sy'n daladwy.

Mae **Rheoliadau 6 i 8** yn nodi'r amodau sy'n gymwys ar gyfer talu grantiau, gan gynnwys gofynion archwilio.

Mae **Rheoliad 9** yn nodi nifer o ofynion eraill y mae'n rhaid i awdurdodau lleol gydymffurfio â hwy os ydynt wedi derbyn grantiau.

Mae **Rheoliad 10** yn caniatáu i'r Cynulliad osod gofynion ychwanegol.

Mae **Rheoliad 11** yn caniatáu i'r Cynulliad fynnu i awdurdod addysg lleol ddirprwyo penderfyniadau ar wario i gyrrff llywodraethu ysgolion.

Mae **Rheoliad 12** yn diddymu Rheoliadau cynt yn ddarostyngedig i ddarpariaethau trosiannol.

Mae'r **Atodlen** yn darparu ar gyfer dibenion y mae grantiau'n daladwy atynt, neu'n gysylltiedig â hwy. Mae paragraffau 1(a), (f),5,19 a 22 wedi'u diwygio ac mae paragraffau 1(k) a 35 yn newydd.

**Regulation 5:** provides for the rate at which grants are payable.

**Regulations 6 to 8:** set out the conditions which apply in respect of the payment of grants, including audit requirements.

**Regulation 9:** sets out a number of other requirements which must be complied with by local education authorities to whom grant payments have been made.

**Regulation 10:** allows the Assembly to impose additional requirements.

**Regulation 11:** allows the Assembly to require local education authorities to delegate spending decisions to school governing bodies.

**Regulation 12:** revokes earlier Regulations subject to transitional provisions.

**Schedule:** provides for the purposes for or in connection with which grants may be paid. Paragraphs 1(a),(f),5,19 and 22 have been amended and paragraphs 1(k) and 35 are new.

Drwy arfer y pwerau a roddwyd i'r Ysgrifennydd Gwladol gan adrannau 484, 489 a 569(4) o Ddeddf Addysg 1996(a) ac a freiniwyd bellach yng Nghynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru(b), mae Cynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru yn gwneud y Rheoliadau canlynol:

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Secretary of State by sections 484, 489 and 569(4) of the Education Act 1996(a) and now vested in the National Assembly for Wales(b), the National Assembly for Wales makes the following Regulations:

1.—(1) Enw'r Rheoliadau hyn yw Rheoliadau Addysg (Grantiau Safonau Addysg) (Cymru) 2000 a deuant i rym ar 1 Ebrill 2000.

(2) Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn gymwys i awdurdodau addysg lleol yng Nghymru.

**Citation, commencement and application**

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Education Standards Grants) (Wales) Regulations 2000 and shall come into force on 1st April 2000.

(2) These Regulations apply in relation to local education authorities in Wales.

**Interpretation**

2.—(1) In these Regulations -

"the 1996 Act" ("*Deddf 1996*") means the Education Act 1996;

"annual review meeting" ("*cyfarfod adolygu blynyddol*") means a meeting to review a statement of special educational needs such as is referred to in regulations 15(5), 16(3) and 17(3) of the Education (Special Educational Needs) Regulations 1994(d);

"approved expenditure" ("*gwariant a gymeradwywyd*") means any expenditure which is approved as provided in regulation 3;

ystyr "athro cofrestredig neu athrawes gofrestredig" ("registered teacher") yw person y rhoddwyd awdurdodiad iddo neu iddi yn unol â Rhan III o Atodlen 2 i Reoliadau Addysg (Cymwysterau a Safonau Iechyd Athrawon) (Cymru) 1999;

ystyr "athro cymwysedig neu athrawes gymwysedig" ("qualified teacher") yw person sydd, yn rhinwedd y rheoliadau(a) ynglŷn â chyflogi athrawon sydd mewn grym o bryd i'w gilydd o dan adran 218 o Ddeddf Diwygio Addysg 1988(b) â chymhwyster i gael ei gyflogi fel athro neu athrawes mewn ysgol o'r math a ddisgrifir yn is-adran (12) o'r adran honno;

ystyr "awdurdod addysg" ("education authority") yw awdurdod addysg lleol yng Nghymru;

ystyr "blwyddyn ariannol" ("financial year") yw cyfnod o ddeuddeng mis sy'n dod i ben ar 31 Mawrth;

ystyr "cyfarfod adolygu blynyddol" ("annual review meeting") yw cyfarfod i adolygu datganiad o anghenion addysgol arbennig fel y cyfeirir ato yn rheoliadau 15(5), 16(3) a 17(3) o Reoliadau Addysg (Anghenion Addysgol Arbennig) 1994(c) ;

ystyr "cyfleusterau amser hamdden" ("leisure-time facilities") yw cyfleusterau o fath y mae awdurdodau addysg dan ddyletswydd i sicrhau eu bod yn cael eu darparu o fewn i'w hardaloedd a'r ddyletswydd honno wedi'i gosod gan adrannau 2(3)(b) a 508(1) o Ddeddf 1996;

ystyr "cyfnodau allweddol 1, 2, 3 a 4" ("key stages 1, 2, 3 and 4") yw'r cyfnodau a bennir ym mharagraffau (a), (b), (c) a (d), yn y drefn honno, o adran 355(1) o Ddeddf 1996;

ystyr "cynllun datblygu ysgol" ("school development plan") yw cynllun a baratowyd gan gorff llywodraethu'r ysgol dan sylw ac sy'n nodi cyrchnodau'r ysgol a'r camau sy'n angenrheidiol dros y blynyddoedd nesaf i alluogi'r ysgol i symud tuag at gyflawni'r cyrchnodau hynny;

ystyr "cynllun strategol addysg" ("education strategic plan") yw cynllun datblygu addysg a baratowyd gan awdurdod addysg yn unol ag adran 6 o

"baseline assessment scheme" ("cynllun asesu gwaelodlin") has the meaning given to it in section 15 of the Education Act 1997(a);

"classroom assistant" ("cynorthwydd ystafell ddosbarth") means an employee of an education authority or of the governing body of a school who is normally present in a classroom with a teacher and who assists the teacher;

"determine" ("penderfynu") means determine by notice in writing;

"education authority" ("awdurdod addysg") means a local education authority in Wales;

"education strategic plan" ("cynllun strategol addysg") means an education development plan prepared by an education authority in accordance with section 6 of the 1998 Act;

"financial year" ("blwyddyn ariannol") means a period of twelve months ending with 31st March;

"grant" ("grant") means a grant in pursuance of these Regulations;

"key stages 1, 2, 3 and 4" ("cyfnodau allweddol 1, 2, 3, a 4") means the periods specified in paragraphs (a), (b), (c) and (d) respectively of section 355(1) of the 1996 Act;

"leisure-time facilities" ("cyfleusterau amser hamdden") means the facilities of a kind which education authorities are under the duty imposed by sections 2(3)(b) and 508(1) of the 1996 Act to secure are provided within their areas;

"mainstream school" ("ysgol brif-ffrwd") means a maintained school other than a special school;

"maintained school" ("ysgol a gynhelir") means a school maintained by an education authority;

"member of the Inspectorate" ("aelod o'r Arolygiaeth") has the meaning given to it in section 46(1) of the School Inspections Act 1996(b);

"mentor" ("mentor") means an experienced head teacher giving advice and assistance to support the professional development of an inexperienced head teacher;

ystyr "cynorthwydd anghenion arbennig" ("*special needs assistant*") yw person sy'n cael ei gyflogi gan awdurdod addysg neu gorff llywodraethu ysgol sydd fel arfer yn bresennol mewn ystafell ddosbarth gydag athro neu athrawes ac sy'n cynorthwyo'r athro neu'r athrawes mewn perthynas â phlant ac iddynt anghenion addysgol arbennig;

ystyr "cynorthwydd ystafell ddosbarth" ("*classroom assistant*") yw person sy'n cael ei gyflogi gan awdurdod addysg neu gan gorff llywodraethu ysgol ac sydd fel arfer yn bresennol mewn ystafell ddosbarth gydag athro neu athrawes ac sy'n cynorthwyo'r athro neu athrawes;

ystyr "y Cynulliad Cenedlaethol" ("*the National Assembly*") yw Cynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru;

ystyr "Deddf 1996" ("*the 1996 Act*") yw Deddf Addysg 1996;

ystyr "Deddf 1998" ("*the 1998 Act*") yw Deddf Safonau a Fframwaith Ysgolion 1998(a) ;

mae "disgybl" ("*pupil*") yn gyfystyr â "pupil" yn adran 3 o Ddeddf 1996;

ystyr "grant" ("*grant*") yw grant yn unol â'r Rheoliadau hyn;

ystyr "gweithiwr ieuencid a chymuned neu weithwraig ieuencid a chymuned" ("*youth and community worker*") yw person sy'n cael ei gyflogi mewn cysylltiad â chyfleusterau amser hamdden, heblaw i wneud gwaith gweinyddol, ysgrifenyddol, clerigol neu gorfforol yn unig;

"named person" ("*person a emwyd*") means a person whom the education authority are satisfied is able (having regard to any criteria set out in the Code of Practice issued under section 313 of the 1996 Act(a)) to provide accurate information and sound advice to a parent about his or her child's special educational needs, and is agreeable to being named as a person from whom the parent may seek such information and advice when the education authority serves a copy of the child's statement of special educational needs on the parent pursuant to paragraph 6 of Schedule 27 to the 1996 Act;

"the National Assembly" ("*y Cynulliad Cenedlaethol*") means the National Assembly for Wales;

"National Grid for Learning" ("*Grid Cenedlaethol ar gyfer Dysgu*") means the system of inter-connecting networks and education services based on the internet which is designed to support teaching, learning, training and administration in schools, the wider education service, and the community;

"prescribed expenditure" ("*gwariant a ragnodwyd*") means expenditure by an education authority for or in connection with any of the purposes specified in the Schedule;

"pupil" ("*disgybl*") has the meaning given to it in section 3 of the 1996 Act;

"qualified teacher" ("*athro cymwysedig neu athrawes gymwysedig*") means a person who, by virtue of the regulations(b) relating to the employment of teachers from time to time in force under section 218 of the Education Reform Act 1988(c), is qualified to be employed as a teacher at a school of the kind described in subsection (12) of that section;

"registered inspector" ("*arolygydd cofrestredig*") means a person who is registered as an inspector in accordance with section 7(1) and (2) of the School Inspections Act 1996;

"registered teacher" ("*athro cofrestredig neu athrawes gofrestrdedig*") means a person to whom an authorisation has been granted in accordance with Part III of Schedule 2 to the Education (Teachers' Qualifications and Health Standards) (Wales) Regulations 1999;

ystyr "ysgol a gynhelir" ("*maintained school*") yw ysgol a gynhelir gan awdurdod addysg;

ystyr "ysgol brif-ffrwd" ("*mainstream school*") yw ysgol a gynhelir nad yw'n ysgol arbennig;

ystyr "ysgol haf ar lythrennedd" ("*summer literacy school*") yw cynllun sy'n diwydd yn ystod gwyliau'r haf ac sydd wedi'i anelu at godi safonau llythrennedd disgyblion sydd ar fin ymuno ag ysgol uwchradd;

ystyr "ysgol haf ar rifedd" ("*summer numeracy school*") yw cynllun sy'n digwydd yn ystod gwyliau'r haf ac sydd wedi'i anelu at godi safonau rhifedd disgyblion sydd ar fin ymuno ag ysgol uwchradd;

mae "ysgol arbennig" ("*special school*") yn gyfystyr â "special school" yn adran 337(1) o Ddeddf 1996(b).

3. Ni fydd grantiau ond yn daladwy ar gyfer gwariant a ragnodwyd ac a dynnwyd neu a dynnir yn ystod blwyddyn ariannol ac ond i'r graddau y cymeradwywyd y gwariant hwnnw am y flwyddyn honno gan y Cynulliad Cenedlaethol at ddibenion y Rheoliadau hyn.

"school development plan" ("*cynllun datblygu ysgol*") means a plan prepared by the governing body of the school in question setting out the goals of the school and the action necessary over the next few years to enable the school to move towards achieving those goals;

"school site" ("*safle ysgol*") has the meaning given to it in paragraph 2(11) of Schedule 3 to the 1998 Act;

"special educational needs" ("*anghenion addysgol arbennig*") has the meaning given to it in section 312(1) of the 1996 Act;

"special needs assistant" ("*cynorthwydd anghenion arbennig*") means an employee of an education authority or of the governing body of a school who is normally present in a classroom with a teacher and who assists the teacher in relation to children with special educational needs;

"special school" ("*ysgol arbennig*") has the meaning given to it in section 337(1) of the 1996 Act(a);

"summer literacy school" ("*ysgol haf ar lythrennedd*") means a scheme taking place during the summer holidays which aims to raise standards of literacy in pupils who are about to join secondary school;

"summer numeracy school" ("*ysgol haf ar rifedd*") means a scheme taking place during the summer holidays which aims to raise standards of numeracy in pupils who are about to join secondary school;

"young person" ("*person ifanc*") has the meaning given to it in section 579(1) of the 1996 Act;

## Expenditure in respect of which grants are payable

3. Grants shall be payable only in respect of prescribed expenditure incurred or to be incurred in a financial year and only to the extent to which that expenditure is approved for that year by the National Assembly for the purposes of these Regulations.

## Grants in respect of payments to third parties

### 4. Where -

(a) an education authority incurs expenditure in making payments, whether by way of maintenance, assistance or otherwise, to any other body or persons (including another education authority) who incur expenditure for or in connection with educational purposes, and

(b) that expenditure of the recipient of the payments or any part thereof would be prescribed expenditure if it were expenditure of the authority,

such payments shall to that extent be treated as prescribed expenditure for the purposes of these Regulations.

## Rate of Grant

5. Grants in respect of approved expenditure incurred on or after 1st April 2000 of the kind referred to in the paragraphs of the Schedule listed in the left hand column of the table below shall be payable at the percentage rate of such expenditure specified in relation thereto in the right hand column of the table.

## Conditions for payment of grant

6.—(1) No payment of grant shall be made except in response to an application in writing from an education authority to the National Assembly, authenticated by the officer of the authority responsible for the administration of their financial affairs or that person's deputy.

(2) Applications for the payment of grant shall relate to expenditure over one or more of the periods specified in paragraph (3) and shall specify the approved expenditure in respect of which grant is applied for which has been or which it is estimated will be incurred by the education authority during each such period.

- (3) The periods referred to in paragraph (2) are -
- (a) 1st April to 31st July;
  - (b) 1st August to 31st December;
  - (c) 1st January to 31st March.

(4) Where an application relating to approved expenditure which has been or which it is estimated will be incurred during the period 1st January to 31st March in any year is submitted under paragraph (1), such payment as the National Assembly may determine, but not exceeding, save where it determines otherwise, three-quarters of the grant applied for in respect of that expenditure may be made forthwith, but no further payment of grant shall be made in respect of that expenditure until a statement has been submitted in accordance with paragraph (5)(a).

(5) Each education authority which has received or seeks to receive a payment of grant in respect of expenditure incurred during any financial year shall, before 31 July in the following financial year or as soon as practicable after that date -

(a) submit to the National Assembly a statement which shall specify the approved expenditure in respect of which grant has been or is being applied for which has been incurred by the education authority during that year; and

(b) secure the submission to the National Assembly of a certificate signed by the auditor appointed by the Audit Commission for Local Authorities and the National Health Service in England and Wales to audit the accounts of the authority or any auditor qualified for such appointment by virtue of section 3(5), (6) and (7) of the Audit Commission Act 1998(a) certifying that in his or her opinion the particulars stated in the statement submitted by the authority pursuant to this paragraph are fairly stated and that the expenditure incurred was approved for the purposes of section 484 of the 1996 Act(b).

(6) No payment of grant shall be made in respect of expenditure incurred by an education authority in the period 1st August to 31st December in any year or any subsequent period if grant was paid to the authority in respect of expenditure in the previous financial year but the National Assembly has not yet received the auditor's certificate referred to in paragraph (5)(b) for that year.

(7) Any under-payment or over-payment of grant which remains outstanding following receipt of the auditor's certificate referred to in paragraph (5)(b) shall, without prejudice to the recovery of any over-payment from any subsequent payment of grant to the education authority, be adjusted by payment between the authority and the National Assembly.

(2) Where conditions have been determined in pursuance of this regulation no grant shall be payable unless such conditions have either been fulfilled or been withdrawn in pursuance of paragraph (3).

(3) The National Assembly may determine to withdraw or, after consulting the education authority, to vary conditions determined in pursuance of this regulation.

#### **Requirements to be complied with**

9. Any education authority to whom a payment of grant has been made shall, if so required by the National Assembly, furnish it with such further information as may be required to enable it to verify that any grant paid has been properly paid under these Regulations.

10. Any education authority to whom a payment of grant has been made shall comply with such requirements (including requirements as to the repayment of grant or the payment to the National Assembly of other sums related to the value of assets acquired, provided or improved with the aid of grant or interest on sums due to it) as may be determined by the National Assembly in the case in question.

11.—(1) The National Assembly may require any education authority to delegate decisions about the spending of-

(a) grant, and

(b) amounts allocated by the authority to meet prescribed expenditure approved in accordance with regulation 3,

to the governing body of a maintained school.

(2) The National Assembly may determine to withdraw or, after consulting the education authority, to vary requirements determined in pursuance of this regulation.
