EXPLANATORY NOTE

Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn diwygio Rheoliadau Ariannu Ysgolion a Gynhelir 1999 gydag effaith o 24 Mawrth 2000 ymlaen.

These Regulations amend The Financing of Maintained Schools Regulations 1999 with effect from 24th March 2000.

Maent yn caniatáu awdurdodau lleol ddsbarthu cyllid ychwanegol sy'n codi yn sgil ailstrwythuro tâl athrawon i'r ysgolion mewn ymateb i'r angen yn yr ysgolion unigol, a hynny am gyfnod trosiannol o hyd at dair blynedd; neu ymgorffori ffactor sy'n gysylltiedig â'r cyllid ychwanegol yn fformwlâu dosbarthu yr Awdurdodau Addysg Lleol o 2000-01 ymlaen.

They allow local authorities to distribute additional funding arising from teachers' pay restructuring to schools in response to the need in individual schools, for a transitional period of up to three years; or to incorporate a factor relating to it in Local Education Authorities distribution formulae from 2000-01.

Ceir tri diwygiad, fel a ganlyn:

There are three amendments, as follows:

1. Diwygir Rheoliad 9 fel y bydd unrhyw ymgynghori ag ysgolion ynghylch newidiadau i'r fformwla ddsbarthu mewn perthynas ag arian ar gyfer ailstrwythuro tâl athrawon neu â chyflogi athrawon uwch-fedrau ar 30 Tachwedd 1999 neu wedyn yn bodloni'r gofynion ynghylch ymgynghori a nodwyd yn y rheoliad hwnnw (rheoliad 2(2)).

1. Regulation 9 is amended so that any consultation with schools on changes to the distribution formula in respect of funding for teachers' pay restructuring or the employment of advanced skills teachers on or after 30 November 1999 will fulfil the consultation requirements set out in that regulation (regulation 2(2)).

2. Diwygir rheoliad 22 er mwyn lleihau'r canran o gyfrannau cyllideb ysgolion cynradd ac ysgolion uwchradd y mae'n rhaid eu pennu ar sail ffactorau sy'n cyfeirio at ddisgyblion o 80% i 75% (rheoliad 2(3)); a

2. Regulation 22 is amended to reduce from 80% to 75% the percentage of the budget shares for primary and secondary schools which must be determined by pupil led factors (regulation 2(3)); and

3. Mewnodi'r paragraff newydd yn Atodlen 2 er mwyn caniatáu, am y blynyddoedd ariannol 2000-01, 2001-02 a 2002-03, i awdurdodau addysg lleol

3. A new paragraph is inserted in Schedule 2 to allow local education authorities, for the financial years 2000-01, 2001-02 and 2002-03, to deduct from

Drwy arfer y pwerau a roddwyd i'r Ysgrifennydd Gwladol gan adrannau 46 a 47 o Ddeddf Safonau a Fframwaith Ysgolion 1998(a) sydd bellach wedi'u breinio yng Nghynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru(b), mae Cynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru yn gwneud y Rheoliadau canlynol:

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by sections 46 and 47 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998(a) and now vested in the National Assembly for Wales(b), the National Assembly for Wales makes the following Regulations:

Enwi, cychwyn, dehongli a chymhwyso**Citation, commencement, interpretation and application**

1.-(1) Enw'r Rheoliadau hyn yw Rheoliadau Ariannu Ysgolion a Gynhelir (Diwygio) (Cymru) 2000 a deuant i rym ar 24 Mawrth 2000.

1.-(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Financing of Maintained Schools (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2000 and shall come into force on 24th March 2000.

(2) Yn y Rheoliadau hyn, ystyr "y prif Reoliadau" (*"the principal Regulations"*) yw Rheoliadau Ariannu Ysgolion a Gynhelir 1999(c).

(2) In these Regulations, "the principal Regulations" (*"y prif Reoliadau"*) means the Financing of Maintained Schools Regulations 1999(c).

(3) Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn gymwys i Gymru yn unig.

(3) These Regulations apply to Wales only.

Diwygio'r prif Reoliadau**Amendment of principal Regulations**

2.-(1) Diwygir y prif Reoliadau fel a ganlyn.

2.-(1) The principal Regulations shall be amended as follows.

(2) Yn rheoliad 9, ar ôl paragraff (4) mewnosdir y paragraff canlynol:

(2) In regulation 9, after paragraph (4) there shall be inserted the following paragraph:

"(4A) In relation to the financial year beginning on 1st April 2000, in respect of proposed changes in a local education authority's formula relating to funding for meeting estimated increases in teacher salary costs referred to in paragraph 40A of Schedule 2 or changes in that formula resulting in the percentage of the amount referred to in regulation 22 which is allocated in one or more of the manners referred to in that regulation decreasing to below 80 per cent, the requirement to consult in paragraph (2) can be satisfied

"(4A) In relation to the financial year beginning on 1st April 2000, in respect of proposed changes in a local education authority's formula relating to funding for meeting estimated increases in teacher salary costs referred to in paragraph 40A of Schedule 2 or changes in that formula resulting in the percentage of the amount referred to in regulation 22 which is allocated in one or more of the manners referred to in that regulation decreasing to below 80 per cent, the requirement to consult in paragraph (2) can be satisfied

(3) Yn rheoliad 22, yn lle “80 canran” gosodir “75 canran”.

(4) Yn Atodlen 2, ar ôl paragraff 40 gosodir y paragraff canlynol -

“40A-(1) In relation to the financial years beginning on 1st April 2000, 1st April 2001 and 1st April 2002, expenditure which the authority estimate they will incur in respect of those financial years in meeting increases in the level of teacher salary costs, as compared with the level of such costs for the financial year beginning on 1st April 1999, being increases arising in consequence of -

(a) any changes in the pay structure for teachers contained in, or given effect to by, any order made under section 2 of the School Teachers’ Pay and Conditions Act 1991(b) coming into force after the date of these Regulations; or

(b) the employment of advanced skills teachers.

(2) In sub-paragraph (1) -

(a) “teacher” does not include a head teacher or deputy head teacher; and

(b) “advanced skills teacher” means a teacher who has been certified by an assessor appointed by the Secretary of State for Education and Employment as eligible for the appointment to that post and who has been so appointed.”.

(3) In regulation 22, there shall be substituted for “80 per cent”, “75 per cent”.

(4) In Schedule 2, after paragraph 40 there shall be inserted the following paragraph -

“40A-(1) In relation to the financial years beginning on 1st April 2000, 1st April 2001 and 1st April 2002, expenditure which the authority estimate they will incur in respect of those financial years in meeting increases in the level of teacher salary costs, as compared with the level of such costs for the financial year beginning on 1st April 1999, being increases arising in consequence of -

(a) any changes in the pay structure for teachers contained in, or given effect to by, any order made under section 2 of the School Teachers’ Pay and Conditions Act 1991(b) coming into force after the date of these Regulations; or

(b) the employment of advanced skills teachers.

(2) In sub-paragraph (1) -

(a) “teacher” does not include a head teacher or deputy head teacher; and

(b) “advanced skills teacher” means a teacher who has been certified by an assessor appointed by the Secretary of State for Education and Employment as eligible for the appointment to that post and who has been so appointed.”.
