The National Assembly for Wales, the Secretary of State, or the Food Standards Agency on behalf of the National Assembly or the Secretary of State, may charge the occupier of any premises (including a holding) at which supervision or inspection is carried out for the purposes of establishing the eligibility for dispatch of products under the Import and Export Restrictions (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) (Wales) (No. 10) Regulations 2001(1) a reasonable fee in respect of costs reasonably incurred by it or her or on its or her behalf.
