PLANT HEALTH, WALES

The Plant Health (Amendment) (Wales) Order 2002

Made - - - - *11th July 2002*

Coming into force - - *6 August 2002*

The National Assembly for Wales, in relation to Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food by sections 2, 3(1) to (4) and 4(1) of the Plant Health Act 1967⁽¹⁾ as read with section 20 of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1972⁽²⁾ and now vested in the National Assembly for Wales⁽³⁾ hereby makes the following Order:

- (3) Section 1(2)(b) of the Plant Health Act 1967 provides that the competent authority in England and Wales for the purposes of that Act is the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food. By virtue of the Transfer of Functions (Wales) (No. 1) Order 1978 (S.I.1978/272), article 2(1) and Schedule 1, the functions of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food under the Plant Health Act 1967 were, so far as they are exercisable in relation to Wales, transferred to the Secretary of State for Wales. These functions of the Secretary of State for Wales were then transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/672).
