The Kava-kava in Food (Wales) Regulations 2002

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations—

“the Act” (“*y Ddeddf*”) means the Food Safety Act 1990;

“Kava-kava” (“*Cafa-cafa*”) means a plant, or any part of or an extract from a plant, belonging to the species *Piper methysticum*;

“port health authority” (“*awdurdod iechyd porthladd*”) means—

in relation to any port health district constituted by order under section 2(3) of the Public Health (Control of Disease) Act 1984⁽¹⁾, a port health authority for that district constituted by order under section 2(4) of that Act.
