The National Assembly for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 66(1), 68(1) and (1A), 69(1), 74A, 75(1), 76(1), and 84 of the Agriculture Act 1970 ^{M1} (as read with regulation 14 of the Food Standards Act 1999 (Transitional and Consequential Provisions and Savings) (England and Wales) Regulations 2000 ^{M2} and articles 2 and 6 of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (Dissolution) Order 2002 ^{M3}), after consultation as required by section 84(1) of that Act and by Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety ^{M4}, and being designated ^{M5} for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 in relation to the common agricultural policy of the European Community, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by that last mentioned section (in so far as these Regulations cannot be made under the powers in the Agriculture Act 1970 specified above), makes the following Regulations:^{F1}
