Maent yn diwygio Rheoliadau Dŵr Mwynol Naturiol, Dŵr Ffynnon a Dŵr Yfed wedi'i Botelu 1999 (O.S. 1999/1540, "y prif Reoliadau"), sy'n ymestyn i Brydain Fawr gyfan ac a ddiwygiwyd eisoes gan Reoliadau Deddf Safonau Bwyd 1999 (Darpariaethau Trosiannol a Chanlyniadol ac Arbedion) (Cymru a Lloegr) 2000 (O.S. 2000/656).
- 2. Mewn perthynas â dŵr ffynnon a dŵr yfed wedi'i botelu, mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn gweithredu Cyfarwyddeb y Cyngor 98/83/EC. Mae'r Gyfarwyddeb honno yn berthnasol i ansawdd dŵr a fwriedir i'w yfed gan bobl (OJ Rhif L330, 5.12.1998, t. 32).

 - (a) yn diwygio'r prif Reoliadau -

The Natural Mineral Water, Spring Water and Bottled Drinking Water (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2003

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

- 1. These Regulations, which apply to Wales only, amend the Natural Mineral Water, Spring Water and Bottled Drinking Water Regulations 1999 (S.I. 1999/1540, "the principal Regulations"), which extend to the whole of Great Britain and which have already been amended by the Food Standards Act 1999 (Transitional and Consequential Provisions and Savings) (England and Wales) Regulations 2000 (S.I. 2000/656).
- 2. These Regulations implement, in relation to spring water and bottled drinking water, Council Directive 98/83/EC relating to the quality of water intended for human consumption (OJ No. L330, 5.12.1998, p.32).
 - 3. These Regulations -
 - (a) amend the principal Regulations by -
 - (i) in regulation 2(1) (the main interpretation provision), amending the definitions of the terms "bottle", "parameter" and "prescribed concentration or value", inserting a definition of the term "Directive 98/83" and substituting a new definition of the term "drinking water" (regulation 3(a)).
 - (ii) substituting a revised version of regulation 2(2), so as to remove otiose wording and make a drafting improvement (*regulation* 3(b)),

- (iii) drwy ychwanegu darpariaeth drosiannol (*rheoliad 2(5)*) sy'n gosod sut mae'r termau "Schedule 3", "parameter" a "prescribed concentration or value" fel y'u defnyddir yn rheoliad 2(1) i'w dehongli cyn 25 Rhagfyr 2003 (*rheoliad 3(c)*),
- (iv) drwy fewnosod darpariaeth (*rheoliad 2(6)*) sy'n rhagnodi sut mae cyfeiriadau yn y prif Reoliadau at farcio neu labelu potel i'w dehongli (*rheoliad 3(c)*),
- (v) drwy addasu geiriad paragraff (c) o reoliad 3 (esemptiadau) (*rheoliad 4*),
- (vi) drwy addasu paragraff (2) o reoliad 4 (adnabod fel dŵr mwynol naturiol) drwy gynnwys ynddo sail ychwanegol y caiff yr awdurdod perthnasol neu'r Ysgrifennydd Gwladol ei defnyddio i dynnu cydnabyddiaeth o ddŵr fel dŵr mwynol naturiol (*rheoliad 5(a*)),
- (vii) drwy roi fersiwn ddiwygiedig o baragraff (5) yn lle'r hen un er mwyn gosod rhwymedigaeth ar awdurdodau perthnasol i roi gwybod i'r Asiantaeth Safonau Bwyd pan fydd yn cydnabod neu'n tynnu cydnabyddiaeth o ddŵr fel dŵr mwynol naturiol (*rheoliad* 5(*b*)),
- (viii) drwy fewnosod gofyniad newydd (rheoliad newydd 4(7A)) bod rhaid i'r awdurdodau perthnasol roi gwybod i'r Asiantaeth Safonau Bwyd am hysbysiadau iddynt am newidiadau o ran disgrifiadau masnachol o ddŵr mwynol naturiol neu enwau ffynhonnau neu darddle (rheoliad 5(c)),
- (ix) drwy egluro rheoliadau 5 (gwahardd rhag gwerthu) a 10 (labelu dŵr mwynol naturiol) (*rheoliadau 6 a 7*),
- drwy roi fersiwn ddiwygiedig o reoliad 11 (dŵr ffynnon) yn lle'r hen un er mwyn addasu'r gofynion sy'n berthnasol i botelu a gwerthu dŵr ffynnon a marcio a labelu poteli sy'n dwyn y dynodiad "spring water"; gan ychwanegu darpariaeth drosiannol sy'n gosod sut mae'r term "Schedule 3", fel y'i defnyddir yn rheoliad 11, i'w ddehongli cyn 25 Rhagfyr 2003; a chan ychwanegu darpariaeth cydnabyddiaeth gilyddol mewn perthynas â dŵr ffynnon sy'n cael ei botelu mewn Gwladwriaeth AEE heblaw'r Deyrnas Unedig (rheoliad 8),
- (xi) drwy roi fersiwn ddiwygiedig o reoliad 12 (dŵr yfed wedi'i botelu) yn lle'r hen un er mwyn addasu'r gofynion sy'n berthnasol i botelu a gwerthu dŵr yfed wedi'i botelu; gan ychwanegu darpariaeth drosiannol sy'n gosod sut mae'r term "Schedule 3", fel y'i defnyddir yn rheoliad 12, i'w ddehongli

- (iii) adding a transitional provision (regulation 2(5)) which lays down how the terms "Schedule 3", "parameter" and "prescribed concentration or value", as used in regulation 2(1), are to be construed prior to 25th December 2003 (regulation 3(c)),
- (iv) inserting a provision (regulation 2(6)) prescribing how references in the principal Regulations to the marking or labelling of a bottle are to be construed (regulation 3(c)),
- (v) modifying the wording of paragraph (c) of regulation 3 (exemptions) (regulation 4),
- (vi) modifying paragraph (2) of regulation 4 (recognition as natural mineral water) by including in it an additional ground on which recognition of water as a natural mineral water may be withdrawn by the relevant authority or the Secretary of State (regulation 5(a)),
- (vii) Substituting a revised version of paragraph (5) of regulation 4 so as to impose an obligation on relevant authorities to inform the Food Standards Agency when they recognise or withdraw recognition of water as a natural mineral water (regulation 5(b)),
- (viii) inserting a requirement (new regulation 4(7A)) that relevant authorities have to inform the Food Standards Agency of notifications to them of changes as regards trade descriptions of natural mineral water or names of springs or origin (regulation 5(c)),
- (ix) Clarifying regulations 5 (prohibition on sale) and 10 (labelling of natural mineral water) (regulations 6 and 7),
- substituting a revised version of regulation 11 (spring water) so as to modify the requirements relating to the bottling and sale of spring water and the marking and labelling of bottles bearing the description "spring water"; adding a transitional provision laying down how the term "Schedule 3", as used in regulation 11, is to be construed prior to 25th December 2003; and adding a mutual recognition provision in respect of spring water bottled in an EEA State other than the United Kingdom (regulation 8),
- (xi) substituting a revised version of regulation 12 (bottled drinking water) so as to modify the requirements relating to the bottling and sale of bottled drinking water; adding a transitional provision laying down how the term "Schedule 3", as used in regulation 12, is to be construed prior to 25th

- (xviii) drwy adolygu, o 25 Rhagfyr 2003 ymlaen, y manylion a bennir yn Rhannau I a II o Atodlen I (manylion y mae'n rhaid i berson eu rhoi os yw'n gwneud cais am gael cydnabod dŵr yn ddŵr mwynol naturiol) (*rheoliad 15*),
- (xix) drwy gywiro gwall teipograffyddol yn Atodlen 2 (manylion anionau, cationau, cyfansoddion sydd heb eu hïoneiddio ac elfennau hybrin) (*rheoliad 16*),
- (xx) drwy adolygu'r gofynion ar gyfer dŵr ffynnon a dŵr yfed wedi'i botelu, gan gynnwys y gofynion ar gyfer crynodiadau neu werthoedd rhagnodedig paramedrau, a

- December 2003; and adding a mutual recognition provision in respect of bottled drinking water bottled in an EEA State other than the United Kingdom (*regulation* 9).
- (xii) substituting a revised version of paragraph (1) of regulation 13 (enforcement) so as to impose an obligation on food authorities, from 25th December 2003, to monitor the quality of spring water and bottled drinking water in accordance with specified requirements of Directive 98/83/EC (regulation 10(a)),
- (xiii) revising the criteria by reference to which water has to be assessed as part of the periodic checks required to be carried out on it pursuant to regulation 13(2)(a) to ensure that it is a natural mineral water (regulation 10(b)),
- (xiv) revising the list of provisions of the principal Regulations referred to in regulation 13(3) for whose purposes specified authorities are not classed as food authorities (regulation 10(c)),
- (xv) substituting a revised version of regulation 16 so as to provide that, with effect from 25th December 2003, the methods of analysis used to check compliance of spring water and bottled drinking water with Schedule 3 have to be carried out in accordance with Article 7.5 of Directive 98/83/EC (regulation 11),
- (xvi) making consequential changes to regulations 17 and 18, which provide respectively for offences and penalties and defences (regulations 12 and 13),
- (xvii) making a minor, clarificatory amendment to regulation 19(3) (which prohibits the sale of bottles of natural mineral water, spring water and drinking water which are not marked or labelled in accordance with regulation 38 of the Food Labelling Regulations 1996, S.I. 1996/1499 as amended) (regulation 14),
- (xviii) revising, from 25th December 2003, the particulars specified in Parts I and II of Schedule 1 (particulars required to be given by a person applying to have a water recognised as a natural mineral water) (regulation 15),
- (xix) correcting a typographical error in Schedule 2 (particulars of anions, cations, non-ionised compounds and trace elements) (regulation 16),
- (xx) revising the requirements as regards spring water and bottled drinking water, including the requirements as regards prescribed concentrations or values of parameters,

The Natural Mineral Water, Spring Water and Bottled Drinking Water (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2003

Made 26th November 2003

Coming into force 1st December 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 16(1), 17(1), 26(1)(a) and (3), 31 and 48(1) of the Food Safety Act 1990(a) and now vested in the National Assembly for Wales(b), the National Assembly for Wales after having regard, in accordance with section 48(4A) of that Act, to relevant advice given by the Food Standards Agency, and after consultation in accordance with section 48(4) and (4B) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Title, commencement and application

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Natural Mineral Water, Spring Water and Bottled Drinking Water (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2003 and shall come into force on 1st December 2003 and shall apply to Wales only.

Amendments to the Natural Mineral Water, Spring Water and Bottled Drinking Water Regulations 1999

- 2. The Natural Mineral Water, Spring Water and Bottled Drinking Water Regulations 1999(c) shall be amended in relation to Wales in accordance with regulations 3 to 21.
 - 3. In regulation 2 (interpretation) -
 - (a) in paragraph (1) -

- (b) Functions of the Secretary of State under the Food Safety Act 1990, so far as exercisable in relation to Wales, were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/672) as read with section 40(3) of the Food Standards Act 1999.

""drinking water" means water intended for sale for drinking by humans other than -

- (a) natural mineral water; or
- (b) water bottled in a bottle marked or labelled "spring water" in accordance with regulation 11;", and
- (iv) in each of the definitions of "parameter" and "prescribed concentration or value", there shall be inserted at the beginning the words "subject to paragraph (5) below,";
- (b) for paragraph (2) there shall be substituted the following paragraph -
 - "(2) Other expressions used both in these Regulations and in Council Directive 80/777 or 80/778 have the same meanings in these Regulations as they bear in the Directive concerned."; and
- (c) after paragraph (4) there shall be added the following paragraphs -
 - "(5) Before 25th December 2003, the references to "Schedule 3", in the definitions of "parameter" and "prescribed concentration or value" in paragraph (1) above, shall have effect as if the amendments made to these Regulations by regulations 17 to 21 of the Natural Mineral Water, Spring Water and Bottled Drinking Water (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2003 had not been made.
 - (6) Any reference in these Regulations to the marking or labelling of a bottle relates both to the case where the marking or labelling occurs before any water is bottled in the bottle and also to the case where it occurs after bottling.".
- **4.** In paragraph (c) of regulation 3 (exemptions) for the words "human consumption" there shall be substituted the words "drinking by humans".
