**NATIONAL ASSISTANCE SERVICES, WALES**

The National Assistance (Sums for Personal Requirements) (Wales) Regulations 2003

*Made* - - - - 26th March 2003

*Coming into force* - - 7th April 2003

The National Assembly for Wales makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by section 22(4) of the National Assistance Act 1948<sup>(1)</sup> and now vested in the National Assembly for Wales<sup>(2)</sup>:—

- (2) The functions of the Secretary of State under section 22(4) of the National Assistance Act 1948 were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/672).
