The Education (Specified Work and Registration) (Wales) Regulations 2004

Name, commencement and application

- 1. These Regulations are called the Education (Specified Work and Registration) (Wales) Regulations 2004 and come into force on 1 September 2004.
 - 2. These Regulations apply in relation to Wales.

Revocations, savings and transitional provisions

- 3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) the Regulations mentioned in Part 1 of Schedule 1 are revoked to the extent specified in that Schedule.
 - (2) The savings and transitional provisions mentioned in Part 2 of Schedule 1 are to have effect.

Interpretation

4. In these Regulations —

"the 1998 Act" ("Deddf 1998") means the Teaching and Higher Education Act 1998(1);

"the 1959 Regulations" ("Rheoliadau 1959") means the Schools Regulations 1959(2);

"the 1982 Regulations" ("Rheoliadau 1982") means the Education (Teachers) Regulations 1982(3);

"the 1989 Regulations" ("Rheoliadau 1989") means the Education (Teachers) Regulations 1989(4);

"the 1993 Regulations" ("Rheoliadau 1993") means the Education (Teachers) Regulations 1993(5);

"the 1999 Regulations" ("Rheoliadau 1999") means the Education (Teachers' Qualifications and Health Standards) (Wales) Regulations 1999(6); and

"the National Assembly" ("y Cynulliad Cenedlaethol") means the National Assembly for Wales.

Requirement to be qualified

- 5. No persons may carry out work specified in regulation 6 in a school unless they
 - (a) are qualified teachers, or

(b) satisfy the requirements specified in Schedule 2.

Specified work

- **6.**—(1) Each of the following activities is specified work for the purposes of these Regulations
 - (a) planning and preparing lessons and courses for pupils;
 - (b) delivering lessons to pupils;
 - (c) assessing the development, progress and attainment of pupils; and
 - (d) reporting on the development, progress and attainment of pupils.
- (2) In paragraph (1)(b) "delivering" includes delivery via distance learning or computer aided techniques.

Requirement to be registered

7. Qualified teachers may carry out work specified in regulation 6 in a school only if they are registered under section 3 of the 1998 Act (register maintained by the General Teaching Council)(7).
