**The Processed Cereal-based Foods and Baby Foods for
Infants and Young Children (Wales) Regulations 2004**

The National Assembly for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6(4), 16(1)(a), (e) and (f), 17(1), 26(1) and (3) and 48(1) of the Food Safety Act 1990 ^{M1} and now vested in it ^{M2}, having had regard in accordance with section 48(4A) of that Act to relevant advice given by the Food Standards Agency and after consultation both as required by Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council ^{M3} laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety and in accordance with section 48(4) and (4B) of that Act, makes the following Regulations:
