# The Head Teachers' Qualifications and Registration (Wales) Regulations 2005

### **Headship Qualification**

- **3.**—(1) Subject to regulation 5 a person may only serve as a head teacher of a school if he or she holds:—
  - (a) the National Professional Qualification for Headship in Wales;
  - (b) the National Professional Qualification for Headship in England(1);
  - (c) the Scottish Standard for Headship(2);
  - (d) the Professional Qualification for Headship in Northern Ireland(3);
  - (e) a qualification which has equivalent effect by virtue of [F1 the 2015 Regulations].
- (2) The National Professional Qualification for Headship in Wales means the qualification awarded by the National Assembly to a person if it is satisfied that the person has successfully [F2met such standards] as the National Assembly may from time to time approve for the purposes of the award of that qualification.
