**CLEAN AIR, WALES**

**The Smoke Control Areas (Exempted  
Fireplaces) (Wales) Order 2005**

*Made* - - - - *1 March 2005*

*Coming into force* - - *5 March 2005*

The National Assembly for Wales (“the National Assembly”), in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Secretary of State by section 21 of the Clean Air Act 1993<sup>(1)</sup> and now vested in the National Assembly<sup>(2)</sup>, and being satisfied that the classes of fireplace exempted by this Order can be used for burning fuel other than authorised fuels without producing any smoke or a substantial quantity of smoke, hereby makes the following Order:
