Application of Part 4

25. This Part applies in respect of animals imported into Wales and which originate outside the [F1European Union] but in respect of which all the checks required under Council Directive 91/496/ EEC have been carried out in another member State.

Imports

26. A person must not import any animal to which this Part applies unless it is accompanied by the common veterinary entry document and the authenticated copy of the original health certificate issued at the point of importation into the [FIEuropean Union] under Article 7(1) of Council Directive 91/496/EEC and Article 3 of Regulation (EC) No. 282/2004.
