**The Kava-kava in Food (Wales) Regulations 2006**

**Prohibition on sale etc. of food consisting of or containing Kava-kava**

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), no person shall—

- (a) sell, or
- (b) possess for sale or offer, expose or advertise for sale, or
- (c) import into Wales from a country outside the United Kingdom or transport into Wales from any other part of the United Kingdom any food consisting of or containing Kava-kava.

[<sup>F1</sup>(2) The prohibition imposed by paragraph (1) does not apply where the food consisting of or containing Kava-kava is imported from a third country if the food is being, or is to be, exported to a third country.]
