

SCHEDULE 3

PARTICULARS PRESCRIBED FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECTION 78R(1)

16. Where, as a result of a consent given under [^{F1}an environmental permit granted under regulation 13 of [^{F2}the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016]], the enforcing authority is precluded by virtue of section 78YB(4) from specifying in a remediation notice any particular thing by way of remediation which it would otherwise have specified in such a notice—

- (a) the [^{F3}environmental permit];
- (b) the location and extent of the contaminated land in question in sufficient detail to enable it to be identified, whether by reference to a plan or otherwise; and
- (c) the matters referred to in sub-paragraphs (c), (d) and (e) of paragraph 1.
