**AGRICULTURAL WAGES**

**The Agricultural Wages Committee (Wales) Order 2007**

*Made* - - - - *14 February 2007*

*Coming into force* - - *1 March 2007*

The National Assembly for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(1) of the Agricultural Wages Act 1948(1), makes the following Order:

**Title, commencement, application and interpretation**

1. The title of this Order is the Agricultural Wages Committee (Wales) Order 2007, it comes into force on 1 March 2007 and applies in relation to Wales.

**Amendment of the Agricultural Wages Committees (Areas) Order 1974**

2. The Agricultural Wages Committees (Areas) Order 1974(2) is amended as follows:
- (a) in Article 3(1) replace the word “Wales” with the words “an agricultural wages committee for the combination of all the counties in Wales”;
  - (b) in Part I of the Schedule, delete the words “Counties in Wales Clwyd Dyfed Gwent Gwynedd Powys”; and
  - (c) in Part II of the Schedule, delete the words “Counties in Wales Mid Glamorgan, South Glamorgan and West Glamorgan”.
