The Spreadable Fats (Marketing Standards) and the Milk and Milk Products (Protection of Designations) (Wales) Regulations 2008

Interpretation

2.—(1) In these Regulations —

"the Act" ("y Ddeddf") means the Food Safety Act 1990;

"the Council Regulation" ("Rheoliad y Cyngor") means Council Regulation (EC) No. 1234/2007 establishing a common organisation of agricultural markets and on specific provisions for certain agricultural products (Single CMO Regulation)(1);

"the Commission Regulation" ("*Rheoliad y Comisiwn*") means Commission Regulation (EC) No.445/2007 laying down certain detailed rules for the application of Council Regulation (EC) No. 2991/94 laying down standards for spreadable fats and of Council Regulation (EEC) No. 1898/87 on the protection of designations used in the marketing of milk and milk products(2);

"food authority" ("awdurdod bwyd") has the meaning it bears by virtue of section 5(1A) of the Act;

[F2"Regulation (EU) 2013" ("Rheoliad (EU) 2013") means [F3Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing a common organisation of the markets in agricultural products], as amended from time to time]

"sell" ("gwerthu") includes possess for sale, and offer, expose or advertise for sale;

"sell by retail" ("manwerthu") means to sell to a person who is not buying for the purpose of re-sale;

[F4" specified provision" ("darpariaeth benodedig") means a provision referred to in regulation 6(2);

"vitamin A" ("fitamin A") means vitamin A present as such or as its esters and includes betacarotene on the basis that 6 micrograms of beta-carotene or 12 micrograms of other biologically active carotenoids equal one microgram of retinol equivalent;

"vitamin D" ("fitamin D") means the anti-rachitic vitamins.

(2) Other expressions used in these Regulations and in the Council Regulation [F5, Regulation (EU) 2013] or the Commission Regulation have the same meaning in these Regulations as they have in the Council Regulation [F5, Regulation (EU) 2013] or the Commission Regulation.
