The School Curriculum in Wales
(Miscellaneous Amendments) Order 2008

The Welsh Ministers make this Order in exercise of the powers conferred on the National Assembly for Wales by sections 101(3)(a), 105(6), 108(3)(c), (7), (8), (9), (10) and (11), and 210(7) of the Education Act 2002⁽¹⁾ and now vested in them⁽²⁾;

In accordance with section 117 of the Education Act 2002, so far as this Order is made in exercise of the powers in section 105(6) of that Act, the Welsh Ministers made arrangements for consultation about the proposals as they considered appropriate;

In accordance with section 210(3) of the Education Act 2002 (as applied by paragraph 34(2) of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006⁽³⁾) a draft of this Order was laid before the National Assembly for Wales and approved by a resolution of the National Assembly.
