EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

The Non-Domestic Rating (Demand Notices) (Wales) Regulations 1993 (S.I. 1993/252) ("the 1993 Regulations") provide for the contents of rate demand notices, which are issued by billing authorities (borough and county councils) in Wales, and for the information to be supplied when such notices are served by them.

These Regulations, which apply in relation to Wales, amend the 1993 Regulations by providing for additional information to be supplied concerning the rating revaluation due to have effect from 1 April 2010 and concerning the small business rate relief scheme established by the Non-Domestic Rating (Small Business Relief) (Wales) Order 2008 (S.I. 2008/2770 (W.246)).

These Regulations only apply in relation to rates payable after 31 March 2009.
