The Zoonoses and Animal By-Products (Fees) (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2008

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 56(1) and (2) of the Finance Act 1973(1) and now vested in them by section 59(5) of the Government of Wales Act 2006(2), and paragraph 1A of Schedule 2 to the European Communities Act 1972(3), and with the consent of the Treasury, make the following Regulations.

Title, application and commencement

1. The title of these Regulations is the Zoonoses and Animal By-Products (Fees) (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2008, they apply in relation to Wales and come into force on 1 January 2009.

Amendments

- **2.**—(1) The Zoonoses and Animal By-Products (Fees) (Wales) Regulations 2008(4) are amended as follows.
 - (2) After regulation 3, paragraph 1(f), insert—
 - "(g) conducting tests under point 4(b)(i) of Part D of Annex II to the European Regulation;
 - (h) conducting tests under point 4(b)(ii) of Part D of Annex II to the European Regulation;
 - (i) conducting tests under point 4(b)(iii) of Part D Annex II to the European Regulation(5)."

These Regulations apply in relation to Wales and make provision for the Welsh Ministers to charge fees for conducting tests that farmers may request under Commission Regulation (EC) No 1237/2007 (OJ No L280, 24.10.2007, p.5). These Regulations amend the Zoonoses and Animal By-Products (Fees) (Wales) Regulations 2008.
