Mae'r Rheoliadau Meini Prawf Purdeb ar gyfer Lliwiau, Melysyddion ac Ychwanegion Bwyd Amrywiol (Cymru) 2009 ("Rheoliadau 2009") yn darparu ar gyfer rhoi ar waith tair Gyfarwydddeb Comisiwn newydd ac sy'n cydgrynhai rheolau presennol y Gymuned Ewropeaidd sy'n llywodraethu meini prawf purdeb ar gyfer lliwiau, melysyddion ac ychwanegion amrywiol eraill a ddefnyddir mewn bwydydd.

The Purity Criteria for Colours, Sweeteners and Miscellaneous Food Additives (Wales) Regulations 2009 ("the 2009 Regulations") provide for the implementation of three new Commission Directives which consolidate existing European Community rules governing the purity criteria for colours, sweeteners and other miscellaneous additives used in foods.

Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn diwygio rheoliad 3 o Reoliadau 2009 i gywiro gwall teipograffyddol yn y testun Cymraeg.

These Regulations amend regulation 3 of the 2009 Regulations to correct a typographical error in the Welsh text.

Nid oes asesiad effaith llawn wedi ei baratoi mewn perthynas â'r Rheoliadau hyn gan na ragwelir unrhyw effaith ar y sector gwirfoddol neu'r sector preifat.

A full impact assessment has not been prepared in relation to these Regulations as no impact on the voluntary or private sector is foreseen.

Yn unol ag adran 48(4A) o'r Ddeddf honno, mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi rhoi sylw i'r cyngor perthnasol a roddwyd gan yr Asiantaeth Safonau Bwyd.

Fel sy'n ofynnol gan Erthygl 9 o Reoliad (EC) Rhif 178/2002 Senedd Ewrop a'r Cyngor, sy'n gosod egwyddorion a gofynion cyffredinol cyfraith bwyd, yn sefydlu Awdurdod Diogelwch Bwyd Ewrop ac yn gosod gweithdrefnau o ran materion diogelwch bwyd(2), cafwyd ymgynghori agored a thryloyw â'r cyhoedd yn ystod cyfnod paratoi a gwerthuso'r Rheoliadau hyn.

The Welsh Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 16(1) (a) and 17(1) of the Food Safety Act 1990(1).

In accordance with section 48(4A) of that Act, the Welsh Ministers have had regard to the relevant advice given by the Food Standards Agency.

As required by Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety(2) there has been open and transparent public consultation during the preparation and evaluation of these Regulations.

The functions formerly exercisable by the "Secretary of State" so far as exercisable in relation to Wales were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/672) as read with section 40(3) of the Food Standards Act 1999 (1999 c.28), and thereafter transferred to the Welsh Ministers by paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006 (2006 c.32).

## **Title, Commencement and Application**

1.—(1) The title of these Regulations is the Purity Criteria for Colours, Sweeteners and Miscellaneous Food Additives (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2009 and they come into force on 7 September 2009.

(2) These Regulations apply in relation to Wales.

## **Amendment of the Purity Criteria for Colours, Sweeteners and Miscellaneous Food Additives (Wales) Regulations 2009**

2.—(1) The Purity Criteria for Colours, Sweeteners and Miscellaneous Food Additives (Wales) Regulations 2009(1) are amended as follows.

(2) In the Welsh text of regulation 3(2)(a) for "Directive 95/45/EC" substitute "Directive 95/31/EC".
