The Official Feed and Food Controls (Wales) Regulations 2009

**PART 3**

OFFICIAL CONTROLS ON FEED AND FOOD OF  
NON-ANIMAL ORIGIN FROM THIRD COUNTRIES

**Checks on products**

**29.**—(1) The person responsible for introducing any product into Wales must permit an authorised officer of an enforcement authority to carry out checks in relation to the product pursuant to [<sup>F1</sup>Articles 34(5) and (6), 44(2) [<sup>F2</sup>, 45(1), (2) and (4), and 49(1)] of Regulation 2017/625].

(2) When an authorised officer is carrying out checks in relation to a product pursuant to [<sup>F1</sup>Articles 34(5) and (6), 44(2) [<sup>F2</sup>, 45(1), (2) and (4), and 49(1)] of Regulation 2017/625], the person introducing the product must provide the facilities and assistance which the authorised officer reasonably requires to carry them out.

(3) When an authorised officer of an enforcement authority is carrying out an identity check or a physical check on a product in accordance with [<sup>F1</sup>Articles 34(5) and (6), 44(2) [<sup>F2</sup>, 45(1), (2) and (4), and 49(1)] of Regulation 2017/625] the officer is entitled to require that the check takes place at a specified place.
