**The Local Transport Act 2008 (Commencement No. 1
and Transitional Provisions) (Wales) Order 2009**

Title, application and interpretation

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the Local Transport Act 2008 (Commencement No.1 and Transitional Provisions) (Wales) Order 2009 and it applies in relation to Wales.

(2) In this Order—

“the Act” (“*y Ddeddf*”) means the Local Transport Act 2008;

“the 1985 Act” (“*Deddf 1985*”) means the Transport Act 1985(1); and

“the 2000 Act” (“*Ddedf 2000*”) means the Transport Act 2000(2).

Commencement of local transport provisions in relation to Wales

2. 1 April 2009 is the appointed day for the coming into force of the following provisions of the Act, subject to the transitional provisions listed in the Schedule to this Order—

- (a) Section 7, and accordingly Schedule 1.
- (b) Section 8 to section 12 inclusive.
- (c) Section 13(1) (insofar as it relates to section 13(2)) and section 13(2).
- (d) Section 46, and accordingly Schedule 2.
- (e) Section 64.
- (f) Section 65(1).
- (g) Section 68(1) (insofar as it relates to section 68(3)) and section 68(3).
- (h) Section 69 to section 71 inclusive.
- (i) Section 75.
- (j) Section 103 to section 108 inclusive.
- (k) Section 109, and accordingly Schedule 5.
- (l) Section 110 to section 111 inclusive.
- (m) Section 112(1).
- (n) Section 113(1) to (4) inclusive.
- (o) Section 114.
- (p) Section 115(1) to (2) inclusive.
- (q) Section 116(1) to (3) inclusive.
- (r) Section 117(1).
- (s) Section 118(1) to (5) inclusive.
