**The Local Education Authorities and Children's
Services Authorities (Integration of Functions)
(Subordinate Legislation) (Wales) Order 2010**

The Welsh Ministers make this Order, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 162 of the Education and Inspections Act 2006(1).

Title, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the Local Education Authorities and Children's Services Authorities (Integration of Functions) (Subordinate Legislation) (Wales) Order 2010 and it comes into force on the thirty-fifth day after the day on which it is made.

(2) In this Order "education subordinate legislation" means subordinate legislation made wholly under powers in any of the Education Acts (within the meaning of the Education Act 1996) and "non-education subordinate legislation" is to be construed accordingly.
